


Directions to the North Appalachian Experimental Watershed (NAEW)

Directions from Columbus, OH to the NAEW

Take I-70 East; exit at SR 37 and go toward Granville. Travel about 9 miles on SR37 and exit to SR 16 and go East. Travel on SR 16 through Newark towards Coshocton. Stay on SR 16 through Coshocton - the route number changes to SR 36 on the East side of Coshocton. At SR 621 turn left (North) off of SR 36 (you will see a sign for the “Hydrologic Station” on SR 36, and a sign for the “North Appalachian Experimental Watershed” at the intersection of SR 621 and 36). Continue to the right at the “Y” in the road (SR 621). The NAEW is about 6 miles North on SR621.



Directions from Zanesville, OH to the NAEW:

From Zanesville, take State Route 60 North toward Dresden. Turn right onto State Route 16 toward Coshocton. At Coshocton, SR 16 becomes SR 36. Take SR 36 East for about 2 - 3 miles. Turn left on State Route 621. (This is well marked. Carter Lumber is on the right.) A very short distance on SR 621, the road Y's; bear to the right. Travel approximately 6 miles and the station is located on the right.

Directions from Cleveland, OH to the NAEW:

Take I-77 South; exit at Newcomerstown (State Route 36). Travel approximately 15 - 20 miles on State Route 36 West. Turn right onto State Route 621. (This is well marked. Carter Lumber is on the left.) A very short distance on SR 621, the road Y's; bear to the right. Travel approximately 6 miles and the station is located on the right.

Directions from Cambridge, OH to the NAEW:

Take I-77 North; exit at Newcomerstown (State Route 36). Travel approximately 15 - 20 miles on State Route 36 West. Turn right onto State Route 621. (This is well marked. Carter Lumber is on the left.) A very short distance on SR 621, the road Y's; bear to the right. Travel approximately 6 miles and the station is located on the right.
