1. What is the shortcut key combination for “Displaying/Editing a text field in a popup window?”


Ctrl + E

2. What is the shortcut key combination for repeating in the current cell the item from the cell directly above?

Ctrl + '


3. What command in the CT will restore the dataview tabs back to the default tabs?

Tools | Reset User Settings




4. How can you as a CT user determine what fields are displayed for a dataview?

Use the Column Chooser tab



5. In the CT, how can you view the lists of any other user in the organization?

Select the Show All checkbox in the List Panel




6. Can you modify those lists?

No. (or Yes) I was originally thinking in a permanent sense _ you cannot permanently modify their lists. But yes, you can change them while you are working with the person's lists - but their lists will stay unchanged. So the correct answer is..."yes" or "no."

7. If you think you have a tab but it is not displayed in the left List Panel, what can you do to display it?

Right-click on a tab and select Show Tab from the menu



8. If you needed a new item to appear in a dropdown list in the CT, how would you go about getting that item added?

Contact the GG administrator - in NPGS, that is of course Quinn Sinnott. He uses the GG Admin Tool to add/edit the codes and Code Groups.

9. What determines who the owner is when you save an Inventory record?

Whoever is designated as the owner of the Inventory Maintenance Policy (that is applied to the Inventory record) is also the owner of the Inventory record.

Inventory Maintenance Policies can be shared across the organization, but remember that when a new inventory record is created, an Inventory Maintenance Policy is applied to the new record.

The owner of the Inventory Maintenance Policy record determines the owner of the inventory record.

10. In the following example, an accession had its Availability indicator as “Contact Site? What would cause that?

The Taxonomic Species record for the Accession has one of the following values in the species' Restriction field: NOXIOUS, RARE, or WEED.

11. When a germplasm order is incoming from the web, the user had selected something that was “available.” An inventory will be assigned to that item request. How does a genebank staff person, the order filler, change the inventory to another inventory lot, assuming she wants to do so?


In the Order Wizard, she could click on the Inventory cell in the Request Items Grid - the Inventory Picker window will display.

Alternatively, in the CT Order Item dataview, you can edit the record. In the Inventory field, remove the suffix which will show the list of all the available inventories, choose which you want to change to, and save the record.

12. True / false: In the CT, all reports are available at all times.

False (They work in conjunction with dataviews, so without the proper dataview, the report will not function.)

13. Where is a listing available of the Curator Tool & Public Website reports?


Refer to the Library Doc which has a link to a Reports spreadsheet. (I will also add a link from the Reports Section" in the CT User Guide.)

14. In the Public Website, today the user only sees one available report listed, but yesterday he saw several listed. Why are they not all listed?

He didn't log in "today," whereas yesterday he saw reports available only to internal genbank personnel.

15. What did the user do in order that the same records displayed two different views (see below)?
He switched "languages."

In the Curator Tool for NPGS, we have an extra language "ENG." Certain dataviews were written to make it easier to bulk add data using codes, rather than the code's equivalent title. To switch languages, use the File Language command:



In the two dataviews below, the first is in the English language; the second in ENG.

16. (Fill-in-the-blank)

If the report isn't visible in the dataview where you expect it, assuming the report was designed to work with that dataview, you need to edit the **Reports Mapping** file.

This is a "toughie." Ideally you will never need to worry about this as a user. However, in the *CT User Guide*, in the *Reports* section, I described a file that controls the "mapping" of reports.
