For the ongoing GG webinar series, please join the meeting room about 5 minutes before the start time. Several notes about the webinars:

When joining, when prompted for the type of client software, select the first one -- **Participant Application:**

AT&T Connect

Select AT&T Connect Software

Select the type of AT&T Connect client software you want to use to connect to this Event:


 **Participant Application (Recommended)**
A Windows-based application with all available AT&T Connect features - including features required by the meeting's Host. To use this option, you must be running the Windows operating system on this computer, and be able to download and install applications. (Supports Accessibility from version 9.0)

 **Web Participant Application**
A browser-based application with some feature limitations. Use this if you are running on a Macintosh or Linux platform, or if you are not able to install software on your Windows computer.



The most feature complete way to join the meeting will be through the "Participant Application" option with voice over your desk telephone.

After completing that selection, you will then have a choice of audio connections. Select the top option, **Call Me:**



Choose Audio Device

Choose one of the following options:


Call Me
Have AT&T Connect call you.

Dial in/Already connected by phone
You want to connect your telephone to the AT&T Connect conferencing system, or you are already connected.


Close

AT&T will call you at your desk phone (the subsequent screen will prompt for your phone number).

If your PC has a microphone and speakers, you can certainly select the “Use microphone and speakers, or headset” option:



The webinar “meeting room” display – similar to the following:



The features for participants using the client application software are fairly self explanatory. The task bar on the top includes icons to raise your hand to ask questions, to send a note (to everyone or just the presenter), and to indicate if you need to step out of the meeting. The explorer bar to the right will show the list of participants (based on how you enter your name when joining the meeting) and a microphone icon will identify whoever is speaking.

AT&T Connect

AT&T Connect (“Connect”) is a software application which we will be using to host the GRIN-Global Introductory Webinar series. Since USDA has a licensing agreement in place, no additional licensing fees are involved and there is no charge to your site.
