Scientific Name : Zea mays

Import Conditions :

- (1). Import Licence is to be sought from the relevant Ministry.
- (2). Consignments must be accompanied with Phytosanitary Certificate from the country of origin issued within 14 days prior to dispatch of the consignments.
- (3). A copy of this Import Permit must be sent to the consignor and must accompany the consignment.
- (4). Consignments must be free from soil and pest.
- (5). Consignments are subjected to inspection or examination prior to clearance by the Customs Office.

Treatment :

Seed treatment with benomyl 2.5 gm a.i per 1000 gm seeds or any suitable fungicide at recommended rate.(The DOA, Malaysia has the right to agree the alternative insecticide or fungicide and please consult the Quarantine Authority of Malaysia)

Additional Declarations :

The seeds (Zea mays) have been obtained from production area OR Lab testing which are free from the following pests/diseases:

- i. Maize Dwarf Mosaic Virus
- ii. Maize Stripe Virus
- iii. Maize Streak Virus
- iv. Maize Rayado Fino Virus
- v. Corn Stunt Virus.

Other Requirements :

1. The country of origin of the seeds must be written clearly on every packaging.
2. Seeds must be clean from the contamination of foreign matters and other weed seeds.
3. Sample to be taken at the point of entry for further analysis. All cost incurred during analysis will be borne by the importer.
4. All re-exporting consignment must be accompanied by the Phytosanitary Certificate from the country of origin and re-export Phytosanitary Certificate from the re-export country.
