Of similar nature is a lot of seeds of trees and shrubs (103421-103439) collected in western China and presented by the Bodnant Gardens of North Wales.

The botanical determinations of these introductions were made and the nomenclature determined by the late H. C. Skeels,<sup>1</sup> who had general supervision of this inventory.
