184765. *SOLANUM CARDIOPHYLLUM* Lindl.

No. 1095. Road from Guadalajara to San Luis Potosí, 201 km. from Guadalajara, Jalisco. Aug. 31. Tubers round, smooth.

184766. *SOLANUM CARDIOPHYLLUM* Lindl.

No. 1096. Matanzas, Jalisco, 238 km. from Guadalajara on the highway to San Luis Potosí. Aug. 31. Tubers of a better flavor than the cultivated potatoes.

184767. *SOLANUM CARDIOPHYLLUM* Lindl.

No. 1097. Hills south of San Luis Potosí, San Luis Potosí State, 322 km. from Guadalajara on highway to San Luis Potosí. Aug. 31. Tubers soft, pale-yellow.

184768. *SOLANUM POLYTRICHON* Rydb.

No. 1098. Canoas, 320 km. from Guadalajara on road to San Luis Potosí, San Luis Potosí State. Sept. 1. Plants rosette-like or with stems, very hairy. Flowers rotate, white; tubers with very pale skin, round to oval.

184769. *SOLANUM CARDIOPHYLLUM* Lindl.

No. 1099. Aguascalientes State, north of Aguascalientes, on track to San Lorenzo, about 5 km. from Aguascalientes-Zacatecas highway. Sept. 5. Tubers with yellowish-brown skin.

184770. *SOLANUM POLYTRICHON* Rydb.

No. 1101. Zacatecas State, Mexico-Zacatecas highway at 726.5 km. from Mexico City. Sept. 14. Plant very hairy; flowers white, tinged with mauve, pentagonal; tubers pale-brown. Said to be taken to market for selling for human consumption.

184771. *SOLANUM CARDIOPHYLLUM* var. *EHRENBERGII* (Bitt.) Correll.

No. 1102. Zacatecas State, Mexico-Zacatecas highway at 726.5 km. from Mexico City. Sept. 14. Corolla stellate, white or slightly mauve-tinged; tubers pale-brown.

184772. *SOLANUM POLYTRICHON* Rydb.

No. 1103. Zacatecas State, Zacatecas-Durango road, very near Zacatecas, Morelos. Sept. 15. Tubers up to 3 by 2.5 by 2 cm., oval to irregular, pale-brown, smooth-skinned.

184773. *SOLANUM POLYTRICHON* Rydb.

No. 1104. Zacatecas State, road to Durango from Zacatecas at Morelos. Sept. 15. Tubers pale-brown.

184774. *SOLANUM PINNATISECTUM* Dun.

No. 1105. Guanajuato State, about 12 km. from Dolores Hidalgo on Guanajuato road, Hernández. Sept. 16.
