

231296 to 231302. ZEA MAYS L. Poaceae.**Corn.**

From the United States. Seeds held in storage at the Regional Plant Introduction Station, Ames, Iowa. Numbered Feb. 17, 1956.

Originally from Northrup, King and Company, Minneapolis, Minn.

231296. 'Bantam' or 'Golden Evergreen'. Northrup, King's Strain No. 9316 13/64F. A 95 days variety, to 7 feet high with heavy stalks, few suckers and medium dark green foliage; ears 7 to 8 inches long, slightly tapered; kernels in 10 to 14 rows, broad, deep yellow; quality fair. A medium late variety selected from a cross between 'Golden Bantam' and 'Stowell's Evergreen' and recommended for home and market gardens.

231297. 'Early Evergreen'. Northrup, King Strain No. 9313F21. A 96 days variety growing 8 feet high with sturdy stalks, few suckers and medium dark green foliage; ears 8 inches long, cylindrical to tapered; kernels in 14 to 18 rows, deep, ranging from broad to narrow, pearly-white. Similar to 'Stowell's Evergreen' except about 4 days earlier.

231298. 'Howling Mob'. Northrup, King Strain No. 8891F22. An 85 days variety growing 7 feet high with stiff stalks, few suckers and medium dark green foliage; ears to 8 inches long; kernels in 12 to 16 rows, shallow, white; quality fair; ships well. An early variety suitable for home and market gardens.

231299. 'Oregon Evergreen'. Northrup, King Strain No. 900. A 98 days variety growing to 9 feet high, quite similar to 'Stowell's Evergreen'; ears 8 inches long; husk is long and tight, affording earworm tolerance and protection in shipping; kernels in 12 to 14 rows, deeper and wider than 'Narrow Grain Evergreen'. Especially adapted to home and market gardens on our Pacific coast.

231300. 'Whipple's White'. Northrup, King Strain No. 8285F21. An 89 days variety growing 6 feet high, yielding heavy fodder, suckers moderately and bears dark green foliage; ears to 7 inches long; kernels in 14 to 18 rows, deep, medium narrow, white, of fair quality. Recommended for home and market gardens.

231301. 'Whipple's Yellow'. Northrup, King Strain No. 8925F22. An 85 days variety growing 6.5 feet high with few suckers, thick stock and medium green foliage; ears 7 inches long, slightly tapered; kernels in 12 to 16 rows, medium deep, wide, yellow, fair to good quality. Vigorous grower tolerant to heat and drought.

231302. 'Golden Giant'. Northrup, King Strain No. 8887F21. An 84 days variety growing to 6 feet high with few suckers and dark green foliage; ears to 8 inches long; kernels in 12 to 16 rows, medium deep and wide, of good quality. A cross between 'Golden Bantam' and 'Howling Mob'. Recommended for the home garden.
