

**231427. RHAMNUS sp. Rhamnaceae.**

From the United States. Plants presented by the Ilgenfritz Nurseries, Monroe, Michigan. Received Mar. 5, 1956.

Probably from India in 1936, with material collected by Walter Koelz.

**231428 to 231439. PISTACIA VERA L. Anacardiaceae.****Common pistache.**

From Iran. Presented by the United States Operations Mission, Tehran. Received Mar. 5, 1956.

**231428 to 231433. Scions**

- 231428.** 'Ibrahimi'. The nut resembles 'Damghan' in size and splitting.
- 231429.** 'Kandani'. Longer and thinner than 'Damghan'; resembles 'Trabonella' in size and appearance.
- 231430.** 'Safeed'. Elongated like 'Trabonella', free splitting, slightly variable in form.
- 231431.** 'Shasti'. Resembles 'Lassen', smaller, not as good.
- 231432.** 'Wahedi'. From the original Wahedi orchard. Nut plump, splitting, uniform in shape, resembles 'Damghan'.
- 231433.** 'Owhadi No. 1'. Regular bearing variety, blossoms late enough to escape all but the latest frost, ripens mostly at one time, harvest easy. Nuts in large clusters, are of good quality, split well, under favorable conditions from  $\frac{3}{4}$  to  $\frac{7}{8}$  inches long; hull pinkish with numerous dark or grayish spots.

**231434 to 231439. Seeds.**

- 231434.** 'Ibrahimi'. Nut resembles 'Damghan' in size and splitting.
- 231435.** 'Khandani'. Longer and thinner than 'Damghan', resembling 'Trabonella' in size and appearance.
- 231436.** 'Owhadi No. 2'. Regular bearing variety, blossoms late enough to escape all but the latest frosts, ripens mostly at one time, harvest easy; nuts in large clusters, good quality, split well, under favorable conditions from  $\frac{3}{4}$  to  $\frac{7}{8}$  inches long; hulls pinkish with numerous dark or grayish spots, often 1 inch or more in length.
- 231437.** 'Safeed'. Elongated like 'Trabonella', free splitting, slightly variable in form.
- 231438.** 'Shasti'. Resembles 'Lassen', but slightly smaller, not considered as good.
- 231439.** 'Wahedi'. (Large). Came from the original Wahedi orchard. Nuts plump, splitting well, uniform in shape, resembles 'Damghan'.
