- 232117.** *AGROPYRON LATIGLUME* (Scribn. & Sm.) Rydb. **Wheatgrass.**
No. 153. Meadow in lodgepole pine, middle fork of Sheeps Creek, road to Spirit Lake (Ashley National Forest), Daggett County, Utah. Elevation 9,000 feet. Plants to 12 inches high.
- 232118.** *AGROPYRON RIPARIUM* Scribn. & Sm. **Streambank wheatgrass.**
No. 340. Scattered on shallow clay soil 9 miles north of Augusta, Route 33 Teton County, Montana. Plants to 3 feet high; spikes 2.5 inches long.
- 232119 to 232122.** *AGROPYRON SMITHII* Rydb. **Bluestem wheatgrass.**
- 232119.** No. 311. North Pacific railroad right-of-way, 2 miles northwest of Bozeman, Route 191, Gallatin County, Montana. Plants to 1.5 feet high; spikes 2 inches long; glumes typical.
- 232120.** No. 312. Scattered along Route 10 north, 2 miles southeast of Winston, Broadwater County, Montana. Elevation 4,900 feet. Plants robust; 2.5 feet high; spikes 2 inches long; poor seeder.
- 232121.** No. 336. Scattered on shallow clay 9 miles north of Augusta, Route 33, Teton County, Montana. Plants to 2 feet high; spikes 5 inches long.
- 232122.** No. 461. Open field 1.5 miles east of Anaconda, road across the Continental Divide to Wisdom, Deer Lodge County, Montana. Elevation 4,000 feet. Plants to 1 foot high; active; abundant.
- 232123 to 232140.** *AGROPYRON SPICATUM* (Pursh) Scribn. & Sm. **Bluebunch wheatgrass.**
- 232123 to 232126.** Step-toe Butte, Whitman County, Washington.
- 232123.** No. 66. Isolated plant on eastern slope, leaves broad; heads 5 inches long; heavy seeder.
- 232124.** No. 67. Isolated clump; spikes to 8 inches long, slender.
- 232125.** No. 68. Elevation 3,600 feet. Isolated clump on rocky bank, 3 feet high; leaves narrow, pilose, curled.
- 232126.** Elevation 3,600 feet. Isolated clump, 3 feet high; awns short; very heavy seeder.
- 232127.** No. 82. Volcanic ridge, Cold Springs Lookout Road, 4.5 miles below South Fork, Cows Creek, Idaho County, Idaho. Elevation 4,000 feet.
- 232128.** No. 85. Slope 0.4 mile off Route 95, Seven Devils Road, Idaho County, Idaho. Fertile clump.
- 232129.** No. 104. Dry hillside, Lamoille Canyon, Elko County, Nevada. Elevation 7,000 feet. Clumps, 3 feet high; most sterile; associated with sagebrush and balsam roots.
- 232130.** No. 118. Dry exposed slope, Lamoille Canyon, Elko County, Nevada. Plants scattered, to 1 foot high; depauperate.
- 232131.** No. 122. Dry, rocky granitic, western slope, Humboldt Range, below Angel Lake, 12.5 miles south of Wells, Elko County, Nevada.
- 232132.** No. 139. Near Snow Basin, Ogden Mountain, off Route 39, Wheeler Springs, Weber Creek, Utah. Plant to 3 feet high; spikes 5 inches long; heavy seeder.
- 232133.** No. 155. Steep rocky slope, Hunslinger, 3 miles south of Summit Springs Ranger Station (Ashley National Forest), Daggett County, Utah. Elevation 8,500 feet.
- 232134.** No. 236. Camping ground, Half Moon Lake, Wind River Mountain, Sublette County, Wyoming. Elevation 8,000 feet.
