- 232171.** No. 218. Meadow along lodgepole pine woods, Green River Lake, Wind River Mountain (Bridger National Forest), Sublette County, Wyoming. Elevation 9,000 feet. Plants to 3 feet high, abundant; spikes heavy, to 6 inches long.
- 232172.** No. 231. Grassy slope northwest side of Green River Lake (Bridger National Forest), Wind River Mountain, Sublette County, Wyoming. Elevation 9,000 feet. Plants to 3.5 feet high.
- 232173.** No. 238. Thicket, north shore Half Moon Lake, Sublette County, Wyoming. Plants to 4 feet high; awns short; spikes to 6 inches long.
- 232174.** No. 260. Lodgepole pine woods 6 miles northwest of Southpass City along Pine Creek, Fremont County, Wyoming. Elevation 9,180 feet.
- 232175.** No. 281. Dry granitic slope of Fiddler's Lake, 24 miles southwest of Lander, Wind River Range, near the Continental Divide, Fremont County, Wyoming. Elevation 10,000 feet. Plants to 2 feet high; atypical.
- 232176.** No. 284. Near switchback, 11 miles northeast of Fiddler's Lake, Wind River Range, Sink Canyon, Fremont County, Wyoming. Elevation 9,900 feet. Plants to 3.5 feet high; spikes to 8 inches long; foliage outstanding.
- 232177.** No. 286. Twelve and one-half miles southwest of Lander, near Sink Canyon, Wind River Range, Fremont County, Wyoming. Elevation 8,500 feet. Plants to 3.5 feet high, outstanding; spikes to 8 inches long; good seeder.
- 232178.** No. 293. Open aspen-spruce woods, 24 miles northwest of Dubois, along Route 187, Fremont County, Wyoming. Elevation 8,500 feet.
- 232179.** No. 296. Scattered on embankment 38 miles southeast of Moran, Route 387, near Togwotee Pass, Fremont County, Wyoming. Elevation 9,600 feet. Plants to 2.5 feet high; spikes thick; good seeder.
- 232180.** No. 300. Dry meadow bordering pine grove, 70 miles southwest of Moran at Togwotee Pass (1 mile west of County line), Teton County, Wyoming. Elevation 9,540 feet. Plants to 2 feet high; spikes short and stout; rhizomes weak.
- 232181.** No. 314. Stemple Pass (Helena National Forest), Lewis and Clark County, Montana. Elevation 6,320 feet. Clump isolated, 2.5 feet high; spikes to 5 inches long; typical.
- 232182.** No. 322. Bear Gulch, Armstrong's Ranch near Lincoln, Lewis and Clark County, Montana. Elevation 4,900 feet. Plant to 3.5 feet high; spikes long, narrow.
- 232183.** No. 323. Bear Gulch, Armstrong's Ranch near Lincoln, Lewis and Clark County, Montana. Elevation 4,900 feet. Clump; heavy seeder.
- 232184.** No. 472. Sedge meadow 4 miles north of Jackson, Beaverhead County, Montana.
- 232185.** No. 487. Scattered through sedge meadow, Yellowstone National Park, Wyoming. Plants to 1.5 feet high.
