- 232301.** No. 183. Subalpine meadow, 20 miles north of New Castle, Buford Road, Garfield County, Colorado. Clumps; inflorescence pale.
- 232302.** No. 197. Mesa Lake (Grand Mesa), Mesa County, Colorado. Elevation 10,000 feet. Plant to 3 feet high.
- 232303.** No. 203. Meadow between Lost Lake and Mesa Lake, Mesa County, Colorado. Plants to 5 feet high; inflorescence pale; panicles upright.
- 232304.** *FESTUCA* sp.
No. 225. Steep shore, lodgepole pine, west side of Green River Lake, Bridger National Forest, Sublette County, Wyoming. Plant 3 feet high; leaves 0.75 inch wide.
- 232305.** *HESPEROCHLOA KINGII* (Wats.) Rydb. Poaceae.
No. 285. Open lodgepole grove, 11 miles northeast of Fiddlers Lake, Wind River Range, Sinks Canyon, Fremont County, Wyoming. Elevation 9,900 feet. Large, stout, isolated clumps to 3 feet high; heavy seeder.
- 232306.** *HYSTRIX CALIFORNICA* (Boland.) Ktze. Poaceae. **Bottlebrushgrass.**
No. 15. Four miles past Inverness Park, road to Point Reyes, Marin County, California. Plant robust, to 7 feet high.
- 232307 to 232309.** *MELICA BULBOSA* Geyer. Poaceae. **Melic.**
- 232307.** No. 174. Spruce woods below Trappers Lake, Garfield County, Colorado. Plants scarce to 1.5 feet high.
- 232308.** No. 184. Meadow near the ranger reseeding experimental plots, 19 miles north of New Castle, road to Buford, Garfield County, Colorado.
- 232309.** No. 187. Meadow, road to Rifle Mount Park off the Buford-New Castle Road, intersection to Guard Station, Garfield County, Colorado. Plants plentiful, robust.
- 232310 and 232311.** *MELICA SUBULATA* (Griseb.) Scribn. **Melic.**
- 232310.** No. 309. Fir woods on dry slope, 20 miles northwest of Bozeman, Battle Ridge Campgrounds, Gallatin County, Montana. Elevation 6,000 feet. Plant 2 feet high; spikelet flowers few.
- 232311.** No. 448. One-half mile northeast of Roger Ranch, Glacier National Park, Camas Creek Valley, Flathead County, Montana.
- 232312.** *ORYZOPSIS ASPERIFOLIA* Michx. Poaceae. **Ricegrass.**
No. 441. Under Douglas firs 3 miles west of Rogers Lake, Glacier National Park, Camas Creek Valley, Flathead County, Montana.
- 232313.** *ORYZOPSIS BLOOMERI* (Boland.) Ricker. **Bloomers ricegrass.**
No. 251. Camping area, east end of Half Moon Lake (Wind River Mountain), Sublette County, Wyoming. Elevation 8,000 feet. Plant with constricted panicles.
- 232314 to 232317.** *ORYZOPSIS EXIGUA* Thurber. **Little ricegrass.**
- 232314.** No. 149. Dry, open, lodgepole pine slope, road between South Fork and Middle Fork, Carter Creek, east of Sheep Creek Park, Daggett County, Utah. Elevation 8,500 feet. Plants to 6 feet high; densely cespitose; heavily grazed.
- 232315.** No. 211. Lodgepole pine woods, Green River Lake (Bridger National Forest, Wind River Mountain), Sublette County, Wyoming.
- 232316.** No. 263. Base of cliff, edge of Lodgepole grove, 6 miles Northwest of Southpass City, Pine Creek (Wind River Range), Fremont County, Wyoming.
- 232317.** No. 277. Lodgepole pine above Fiddlers Lake, 24 miles southwest of Lander, Fremont County, Wyoming. Elevation 10,000 feet. Plants to 1 foot high; robust. (Associated with *Festuca idahoensis*).
