- 232519.** *JUNCUS TRACYI* Rydb. **Rush.**
No. 514. Wet slope, edge of Douglas fir and aspen woods, Yellowstone National Park, 5.6 miles west of Tower Junction, Wyoming. Elevation 7,500 feet.
- 232520.** *JUNCUS TWEEDYI* Rydb. **Rush.**
No. 502. Edge of hot spring, West Thumb, Yellowstone National Park, Wyoming. Elevation 7,700 feet.
- 232521 to 232523.** *LUZULA GLABRATA* (Hoppe) Desv. Juncaceae. **Woodrush.**
- 232521.** No. 56. Above snow bank, Crater Lake National Park, Mount Thielsen, Klamath County, Oregon. Elevation 8,120 feet. Plants few.
- 232522.** No. 59. Along hillside under Douglas firs, near Ranger Headquarters, Crater Lake National Park, Klamath County, Oregon. Elevation 6,000 feet. Plants to 6 inches high, abundant, very succulent; leaves broad.
- 232523.** No. 391. Meadow on eastern slope, Logan Pass, Clements Mountain, Hanging Gardens, Glacier County, Montana. Elevation 7,000 feet.
- 232524.** *LUZULA PARVIFLORA* (Ehrh.) Desv. **Millet woodrush.**
No. 266. Lodgepole pinewoods, 7 miles northwest of Southpass City, along Pine Creek, Fremont County, Wyoming. Elevation 7,200 feet.
- 232525.** *LUZULA PIPERI* (Coville) Jones **Woodrush.**
No. 271. Lodgepole pinewoods, Fiddlers Lake, 24 miles southwest of Lander, Fremont County, Wyoming. Elevation 10,000 feet.
- 232526.** *ACONITUM BAKERI* Greene. Ranunculaceae. **Baker monkshood.**
No. 112. Aspen woods along a stream, Lamoille Canyon, Elko County, Nevada.
- 232527.** *ALLIUM NUTTALLII* Wats. Liliaceae.
No. 240. Willow thicket on north shore, Half Moon Lake, Wind River Mountains, Sublette County, Wyoming. A possible ornamental.
- 232528 to 232530.** *AMELANCHIER ALNIFOLIA* Nutt. Malaceae. **Serviceberry.**
- 232528.** No. 140. Dry slope near a gully above the Trappist Monastery in the Wasatch Range, Weber County, Utah. Elevation 6,300 feet.
- 232529.** No. 164. Steep rocky slope along the White River Valley, 20 miles west of Trappers Lake, Route 132, Rio Blanco County, Colorado. Plant 15 feet high; fruit large, blue, 0.5 inch in diameter.
- 232530.** No. 194. Five miles north of Mesa Lake, Route 65 (Grand Mesa), Mesa County, Colorado. Elevation 8,500 feet. Plant 10 feet high; fruit large, palatable.
- 232531.** *AMELANCHIER* sp.
No. 358. Loose gravelly soil, rocky trail east of Mount Altyn and southwest of Swiftcurrent Lake on Appekunny Mountain, Glacier National Park, Glacier County, Montana. Fruit large, juicy; rust present.
- 232532.** *AQUILEGIA FORMOSA* Fisch. Ranunculaceae. **Columbine.**
No. 111. Aspen woods, Lamoille Canyon, Elko County, Nevada. Plant prolific flowering; heavy seeder.
- 232533.** *ASTRAGALUS AGRESTIS* Dougl. Fabaceae. **Purple milkvetch.**
No. 259. Lodgepole pine clearing, 6 miles northwest of Southpass City along Pine Creek, Fremont County, Wyoming. Elevation 7,190 feet.
- 232534 to 232537.** *ASTRAGALUS ALPINUS* L. **Alpine milkvetch.**
- 232534.** No. 214. Edge of dried streamlet in a lodgepole pinewoods, Green River Lake area, Sublette County, Wyoming. Elevation 9,000 feet.
