* 235315. *CAMELLIA* sp.

Col. No. 533. Kyoto University Experiment Forest, Oshima Island, Kushimoto, Wakayama. Plant characterized by dark shiny, narrowly pointed leaves; flowers white, small, single.

Received as *C. wabishe*, an apparently unpublished name.

235316. *CHRYSANTHEMUM JAPONENSE* Nakai Asteraceae.

Col. No. 505. In full sun above sea cliff, Ashizuri-zaki. Leaves small; flowers in December, white with yellow center.

Collected as variety *ashizuriense*.

235317. *DAMNACANTHUS MACROPHYLLUS* var. *GIGANTEUS* Koidz. Rubiaceae.

Col. No. 552. Damp woods, Gegu Shrine Forest, Ise City, Mie Prefecture. Small, evergreen shrub; leaves opposite, ovate with small spines; fruits solitary, red.

235318. *DICRANOPTERIS DICHOTOMA* Bernh. Polypodiaceae.

Col. No. 525. In damp forest, Shirohama, Kii, Wakayama. Evergreen fern; fronds linear, deeply lobed; rhizome stout, ramifying.

235319. *DISTYLIUM RACEMOSUM* Sieb. & Zucc. Hamamelidaceae.

Col. No. 530. Oshima Island, near Kushimoto, Wakayama-ken. Evergreen tree; habit upright, stiff; used extensively for hedges and windbreaks.

235320. *EUCHRESTA JAPONICA* Benth. Fabaceae.

Col. No. 541. In cryptomeria forest, Nachi-san, Kii, Wakayama-ken. Small evergreen shrub; leaves trifoliate, leaflet ovate; pod dark purple, one-seeded.

235321. *HEMEROCALLIS AURANTIACA* var. *LITTOREA* Makino Liliaceae.

Daylily.

Col. No. 504. On face of sea cliffs, Ashizuri-zaki. Flowers orange-red, blooming in late October.

235322. *HUGERIA JAPONICA* Nakai Eriaceae.

Col. No. 543. Along mountain path, Nachi-san, Kii, Wakayama Prefecture. Small evergreen shrub; stems and branchlets green, leaves ovate-lanceolate, finely serrate; flowers white; berries red.

235323. *HYMENOPHYLLUM BARBATUM* Miq. Hymenophyllaceae.

Col. No. 538. Along mountain path, Nachi-san, Kii, Wakayama Prefecture. Small evergreen fern on damp rocky walls of ravines; fronds very thin, filmy; margin serrate.

* 235324. *HYMENOPHYLLUM INTEGRUM* Bosch.

Col. No. 539. In damp woods of mountain forest on rocky walls of ravines, Nachi-san, Kii, Wakayama Prefecture.

235325. *LIPARIS NERVOSA* Lindl. Orchidaceae.

Col. No. 550. Forest of Gegu Shrine, Ise City, Mie Prefecture. Wild, terrestrial orchid; leaves ovate; flowers in a spike, greenish, small.

235326. *PELLIONIA MINIMA* Makino Urticaceae.

Col. No. 537. In damp woods of cryptomeria forest, Nachi-san, Kii, Wakayama Prefecture. Wild, prostrate evergreen plant; stems purplish; leaves shiny, ovate.

235327. *RHODODENDRON SERPYLLIFOLIUM* (A. Gray) Miq. Ericaceae.

Col. No. 544. Along mountain path, Nachi-san, Kii, Wakayama. Small evergreen species; leaves minute; flowers white, 0.75 inches across.
