235500. *CAMELLIA OLEIFORA* Abel. Theaceae.

Col. No. 535. In Kyoto University Experimental Forest, Oshima Island, Kushimoto, Wakayama-ken. Evergreen shrub; flowers white, single, rather small; grown as a source of oil.

235501. *CASTANOPSIS CUSPIDATA* (Thunb.) Schottky. Fagaceae.

Col. No. 555. Forest of Gegu Shrine, Ise City, Mie Prefecture. Wild evergreen tree to 65 feet high, 18 inches in diameter; leaves narrow, lanceolate; acorns small, edible, black.

* **235502.** *EURYA OCHNACEA* (DC.) Szysz. Theaceae.

Col. No. 545. Entrance to Kumano Shrine, Nachi-san, Wakayama Prefecture. Small evergreen tree or shrub; leaves ovate, entire; flowers white; berries black.

235503. *COCCULUS TRILOBUS* (Thunb.) DC. Menispermaceae.

Col. No. 522. Kashima Island, Tanabe, Wakayama Prefecture. Scandant vine; leaves round; fruit in large clusters, bright blue.

235504. *CRINUM ASIATICUM* var. *JAPONICUM* Baker. Amaryllidaceae.

Col. No. 529. Along roadside, Oshima Island, Kushimoto, Wakayama Prefecture. Flowers white, in large clusters, July to August.

235505. *DISTYLIUM RACEMOSUM* Sieb. & Zucc. Hamamelidaceae.

Col. No. 530. Along roadside as hedge plant, Oshima Island, Kushimoto, Wakayama Prefecture. Evergreen tree; grown as hedge or windbreak; leaves ovate, entire.

235506. *EUCHRESTA JAPONICA* Benth. Fabaceae.

Col. No. 541. In forest at Nachi-san, Wakayama Prefecture. Small evergreen shrub; running habit; leaves trifoliate, dark shiny green; pod dark purple, one seeded.

* **235507.** *HEMEROCALLIS AURANTIACA* var. *LITTOREA* Makino Liliaceae.

Daylily.

Col. No. 504. On face of sea cliff, in full sun, Ashizurizaki, Shikoku. Flowers orange red, in late October.

235508. *ILEX INTEGRA* Thunb. Aquifoliaceae.

Holly.

Col. No. 501. Ashizurizaki, National Forest Ashizuri, Shikoku. Evergreen tree to 40 feet high; leaves entire; fruits usually in pairs, red, ovoid, largest of any species.

* **235509.** *ILEX SERRATA* var. *SIEBOLDII* Loes.

Holly.

Col. No. 563. At Shingu City, Mie Prefecture. Wild deciduous form; fruits bright red; peduncles short; prodigious bearing habit.

* **235510.** *LASIANTHUS JAPONICUS* Miq. Rubiaceae.

Col. No. 498. Nakamura City, Ashizurizaki, Shikoku. Evergreen shrub; flowers white, axillary; fruit brilliant blue, in October.

235511 and 235512. *LASIANTHUS SATSUMENSIS* Matsum.

* * **235511.** Col. No. 499. Nakamura City, Ashizurizaki, Shikoku. Leaves glaucous underneath.

* * **235512.** Col. No. 548. In dense forest, Nachi-san, Wakayama Prefecture. Small, evergreen shrub; leaves lanceolate, entire, dark green above; fruits in axillary cymes, bright blue.

* **235513.** *PHOTINIA VILLOSA* var. *LAEVIS* (Thunb.) Dipp. Malaceae.

Col. No. 565. Shingu City, Mie Prefecture. Handsome deciduous shrub; fruits red, oblong; foliage good red fall color.
