235514. *QUERCUS GLAUCA* Thunb. Fagaceae. **Blue Japanese oak.**

Col. No. 554. Forest of Gegu Shrine, Ise City, Mie Prefecture. Tree evergreen, 50 feet high; leaves ovate, coarsely serrate, shiny above, glaucous beneath.

235515. *SCIADOPITYS VERTICILLATA* (Thunb.) Sieb. & Zucc. Pinaceae. **Umbrellapine.**

Col. No. 562. In forest of Gegu Shrine, Ise City, Mie Prefecture. Conifer to 100 feet high; typical.

235516. *TSUGA SIEBOLDII* Carr. Pinaceae. **Hemlock.**

Col. No. 561. Forest of Gegu Shrine, Ise City, Mie Prefecture. Handsome species, characterized by having entire leaf margins and notched apex; cones large, sharply pointed.

235517. *TUBOCAPSICUM ANOMALUM* (Franch. & Sav.) Makino. Solanaceae.

Col. No. 524. In forest of Shrine, Shirohama, Wakayama Prefecture. A subshrub; stems green; fruits bright orange, hanging on stalks to 2 inches long.

235518. *VIBURNUM JAPONICUM* (Thunb.) Spreng. Caprifoliaceae.

Col. No. 532. Kyoto University Experimental Forest, Oshima Island, Wakayama Prefecture. An evergreen species with dense cymes of red fruit; cultivated to some extent.

235519. (Undetermined.)

Col. No. 549. In *Cryptomeria* forest, Nachi-san, Wakayama Prefecture. Small vine; leaves trifoliate; pods 2 inches long, bright purple, quite ornamental.

235520. (Undetermined.)

Col. No. 566. In Botanic Garden, Gegu Shrine, Ise City, Mie Prefecture. An evergreen shrub to 8 feet high; leaves opposite, entire; fruits black.
