Col. No. 144. East of Bogota, Colombia. Elevation 2,892 meters. Wild; fruits large.

237099. *RUBUS GACHETENSIS* Berger

Col. No. 145. East of Bogota, on Chipaque Road. Elevation 3,200 meters. Wild; giant globose black berry.

237100 and 237101. *RUBUS MACROCARPUS* Benth. **Colombian blackberry.**

237100. Col. No. 140. Roadside beyond San Miguel, Bogota, Colombia. Fruits and flower buds large.

237101. Col. No. 146. Tunguragua, Ecuador.

237102. *RUBUS ROSEUS* Poir.

Col. No. 137. Tunguragua, 18 km. from Banos, road to Rio Bamba, Ecuador. Plants large, very productive; fruits large.

237103. *RUBUS* sp.

Col. No. 133. Above road, 28 km. from Banos, Ecuador. Elevation 2,800 meters. Plant wild; fruit black berry, clustered, large.

237104. *RUBUS* sp.

Col. No. 134. Twenty-eight km. from Banos toward Ambato, Ecuador. Elevation 2,800 meters. Plant wild; berry black, clustered, giant.

237105. *RUBUS* sp.

Col. No. 141. Roadside beyond San Miguel, 44 km. from hotel, Fusagasuga Road, Bogota, Colombia. Plant wild; fruits medium-sized.

237106. *RUBUS* sp.

Col. No. 142. Roadside beyond San Miguel, 44 km. from hotel on Fusagasuga Road, Bogota, Colombia. Plant wild; fruits small.

237107. *ALLIUM SATIVUM* L. Liliaceae. **Garlic.**

From the United States. Cloves growing at the Regional Plant Introduction Station, Geneva, New York. Numbered Jan. 28, 1957.

N.H. #21. 'Egyptian'. Collected by E. M. Meader in Seabrook, N.H. Plant makes top-sets useful for flavoring in addition to the usual cloves.
