241909. *OCHNA MULTIFLORA* DC. Ochnaceae.

Col. No. 5134. Evergreen shrub; flowers bright yellow; fruit greenish; seeds black, protruding. (Seeds.)

241910. *RHAMNUS ALATERNUS* L. Rhamnaceae.

Col. No. 5132. Along the Rio Mondego, east of Coimbra. Evergreen shrub; fruits black, berrylike, juicy. (Seeds.)

241911. *ROSA* (hybrid). Rosaceae.

Col. No. 5129. 'Belle of Portugal' (*R. odorata* var. *gigantea* × Tea Rose). Botanical Garden, University of Coimbra. Climber; flowers bluish pink; double; stems weak.

241912 and 241913. *LOLIUM MULTIFLORUM* Lam. Poaceae.
Italian ryegrass.

241914. *BANKSIA INTEGRIFLOIA* L. f. Proteaceae.

Col. No. 5112. Park da Pena, near Sintra, west of Lisbon. Evergreen tree to 50 feet high; leaves oblong, green above, white below; flowers yellow.

241915 and 241916. Botanical Garden, University of Lisbon.

241915. *CESTRUM FASCICULATUM* (Endl.) Miers Solanaceae.

Col. No. 5100. Shrub; branches drooping; flowers, pendulous, carmine.

241916. *EUPATORIUM OMPHALIAEFOLIUM* Kunth & Bouche Asteraceae.

Col. No. 5103. Shrub to 12 feet high; leaves fleshy, lustrous above.

241917 and 241918. *ILEX PERADO* Ait. Aquifoliaceae.

Park da Pena, Sintra, west of Lisbon.

241917. Col. No. 5109. Evergreen tree to 20 feet high; leaves thick, spiny.

241918. Col. No. 5111. Evergreen tree; leaves thick, spiny, lustrous above.

241919. *LIMONIASTRUM MONOPETALUM* (L.) Boiss. Plumbaginaceae.

Col. No. 5102. Botanical Garden, University of Lisbon. Shrub to 10 feet high; branches pendulous; leaves glaucous; flowers lavender-pink.

241920. *OLEA EUROPAEA* L. Oleaceae. **Olive.**

Col. No. 5098. 'Sylvatica'. Instituto Superior de Agronomia, Lisbon. Tree to 30 feet high, large and more spreading than the common olive; fruit insignificant.

241921 to 241923. Park da Pena, Sintra, near Lisbon.

241921. *OREOPANAX* sp. Araliaceae.

Col. No. 5107. Evergreen shrub to 10 feet high; leaves shallowly lobed, scurfy tomentose.
