A large tree; wood is a possible substitute for mahogany; the seed are used as a soup thickening.

- 244614.** PENTACLETHRA MACROPHYLLA Benth. Mimosaceae.

Tree produces pods to 18 inches long; seeds yield to 45 percent oil and are rich in protein, exceeded only by *Glycine max* and *Vicia faba*, but are poor in starch; beans are commonly eaten after roasting but used more as a condiment than as a staple food; oil used in soups, for candles, and for lubrication.
