

246729. *CORONILLA VIMINALIS* Salisb. Fabaceae.

BN-7891. A trailing shrub; flowers pale-red or white striped with red formed in small umbels. Native to Algeria, tender at Beltsville.

246730. *LOTUS CORNICULATUS* var. *CILIATUS* (Tenore) C. Koch Fabaceae.

BN-7905. Annual to 1.5 foot high; peduncle twice as long as leaf, 1-to-2-flowered; calyx longer than the tube; corolla yellow, keel obtuse-angled pod slender, straight, 5 to 7 times as long as calyx. Flowers April and May.

246731. *LOTUS TENUIS* Waldst. & Kit. ex Willd.

BN-7907. Perennial to 2 feet high, shrubby at the base; resembling *L. corniculatus*, except leaves are narrower and the flowers are usually pink. One of the few pasture-producing legumes of Australia. Plant somewhat poisonous (hydrocyanic acid).

BN-8588. Showy shrub to three feet high; leaflets oblong, denticulate; flowers yellow, in terminal leafy racemes, standard striped with red; pods linear, about twice as long as calyx. Seeds 6 to 9, tuberculate.

246744. *PSORALEA BITUMINOSA* L. Fabaceae.

Scurf-pea.

BN-8690. Perennial to 3.5 feet high, leafy; flowers blue; calyx lobes subulate, longer than tube; pod hirsute, ovate, flattened, exerted beak.

Perennial to one foot high, sparsely leaved; flowers white; keel purple.

Erect, vigorous perennial to two feet high; flowers small, blue or purple, very shortly pedicellate in dense interrupted racemes; pod ovoid, slightly pubescent. Native to Australia.
