

254453. Col. No. 16802. Rocky slope. Elevation 2,600 feet. Tall, bushy shrub; about 2% of capsules two- to three-fasciculate, but not dehiscent. The clustered fruit character and seed size makes this a lot for progeny selection.
254454. Col. No. 16803. Rocky gully. Elevation 2,600 feet. Shrub with medium size elliptic capsules; wax content of seeds 42.8%.
254455. Col. No. 16804. Superior. Elevation 2,700 feet. Seeds from mixed collection.
254456. Col. No. 16807. Arboretum, Superior. Erect, symmetrical shrub to seven feet high with spreading crown, polypodial; flowers at alternate nodes; seed capsules long, few.
254457. Col. No. 16808. East of Superior, road to Phoenix. Elevation 2,000 feet. Robust spreading shrub to 4.5 feet high; leaves large, glaucous; seeds large, grooved, light brown.
254458. Col. No. 16809. Along Apache Trail. Elevation 3,000 feet. A mixed collection from shrubs below Roosevelt Dam.
254459. Col. No. 16814. Rocky alluvium, Cave Creek. Elevation 2,000 feet. Small, low-spreading bush; foliage light; capsules about 20% fruit, two- to four-fasciculate; flowers at every node. The clustered fruits should be reflected in the progeny by superior yielding individuals under cultivation.
254460. Col. No. 16815. Granitic alluvium, Cave Creek. Elevation 2,100 feet. Tall shrub, with open habit; foliage sparse, at every other node; capsules large, one- to three-seeded; seeds large.
254461. Col. No. 16816. Cave Creek. Elevation 2,100 feet. Seed collected from several shrubs.
254462. Col. No. 16817. Granitic sand, northeast of Camp Creek. Elevation 3,500 feet. Low-spreading, open shrub; stem few; leaves sparse, large; capsules large, single-seed; seeds large. Selected for low, open habit with non-bushy base and large seed.
254463. Col. No. 16818. Granitic sand, northeast of Cave Creek, along Camp Creek road. Elevation 3,100 feet. Slender, erect shrub; branches arching; fair set of large double-seeded capsules that dehisce. Selected for habit.
254464. Col. No. 16819. Granitic slope, two miles south of Camp Creek. Elevation 3,600 feet. Plant cold-hardy, six feet high; capsules few, which split freely on drying; seeds dark brown to black.
254465. Col. No. 16821. Granitic slope two miles south of Camp Creek. Elevation 3,600 feet. Small, spreading, cold-hardy shrub; leaves large, capsules large.
254466. Col. No. 16822. Granitic slope south of Camp Creek. Elevation 3,600 feet. Small, erect, cold-hardy shrub; leaves sparse; seeds russet.
254467. Col. No. 16823. Granitic slope, camp Creek. Elevation 3,500 feet. Bush to six feet high; shoots long; capsules extremely long, slender. The long capsules may produce seeds of large size.
254468. Col. No. 16824. Granitic slope four miles south of Camp Creek. Elevation 3,100 feet. Shrub well-formed; leaves sparse; capsules small, good set, dehiscent readily; seeds single, russet colored, uniform.
254469. Col. No. 16825. Granitic slope four miles south of Camp Creek. Elevation 3,100 feet. Bush to nine feet high; leaves glaucous-green, thick; shoots strong; new growth setting flowers at every node; capsules ovate, thick; seeds dark brown, large, deeply furrowed, short. Probably of cold-hardy strain.
254470. Col. No. 16826. Granitic slope. Elevation 3,100 feet. Cold-hardy bush, six feet high; seeds large, black.
254471. Col. No. 16827. Granitic slope four miles south of Camp Creek. Elevation 3,100 feet. Tall, cold-hardy shrub with good habit, open at base; internodes long; capsules long one-seeded; seeds russet-colored.
254472. Col. No. 16828. Granitic slope, four miles south of Camp Creek. Elevation 3,100 feet. Tall, slender bush; internodes long; leaves sparse;
