304561. *TEPHROSIA SUBTRIFLORA* Hochst. ex. Bak. Leguminosae.

Col. No. K 52329. Small, prostrate annual 1.5 feet high, flowers red.

304562. *TEPHROSIA VILLOSA* (L.) Pers.

Col. No. K 52326. Erect annual shrub 1.5 to 3 feet high, pods very hairy, twisted, unpalatable to stock. Origin Taneta, semidesert country in southeast Kenya. Flowers purple.

304563. *TEPHROSIA* sp.

Col. No. K 5355. (*T. cf. orientalis* Bal.; *T. cf. muenzneri* Harms.; not *T. holstii*). Perennial shrub 1.5 to 2.5 feet high. Common in Kenya in in areas of good rainfall, elevations 5,000 to 7,000 feet.

Received originally April 1957 from Centro Nacional De Agronomia, Santa Tecla, El Salvador.

304565. *TEPHROSIA GRANDIFLORA* (Ait.) Pers.

Received originally June 1957 from Division of Botany, Department of Agriculture, Pretoria, Union of South Africa. Collected near coast of Natal. Short-lived perennial best adapted to subtropical moist climate. Shrub 1.5 feet high, flowers purple.
