**305402. MAGNOLIA FUSCATA Andr. Magnoliaceae.**

Flowers creamy white, fragrant, to 8 inches across, in flower March to June and July to October in Calcutta.

**305403. MAGNOLIA MUTABILIS Regel**

Flowers buff, fragrant, to 8 inches across, in flower almost all year in Calcutta.

**305404. MAGNOLIA PTEROCARPA Roxb.**

Flowers white, March to June in Calcutta.

**305405. MAGNOLIA PUMILA Andr.**

Flowers white, fragrant, to 8 inches across, in flower almost all year in Calcutta.

**305406. MAGNOLIA SOULANGIANA Soul.**

An evergreen magnolia.

**305407. MICHELIA ALBA DC. Magnoliaceae.**

Tree tall; flowers white, fragrant, in flower almost all year in Calcutta.

**305408. MICHELIA CHAMPACA L.****Champac.**

Flowers yellow, fragrant, in flower almost all year in Calcutta.

**305409. HAGENIA ABYSSINICA (Bruce) J. F. Gmel. Rosaceae.**

From Ethiopia. Seeds presented by the Forestry Department, Ministry of Agriculture, Addis Ababa. Received Apr. 7, 1965.

Elevation 2,400 to 3,000 meters. Tree to 20 meters, dioecious.

**305410. CASSIA ABBREVIATA Oliv. var. GRANITICA (Bak. f.) Bak. f. Leguminosae. Longtail cassia.**

From the Republic of South Africa. Seeds presented by the Plant Introduction Officer, Department of Agricultural Technical Services, Pretoria. Received Apr. 9, 1965.

Tree to 20 feet high, trunk slender, foliage fine. Browse plant.
