378650. *DIOSCOREOPHYLLUM CUMMINSHII* (Stapf) Diels **Menispermaceae.**

Slender vine somewhat resembling *Dioscorea*. Edible tubers resemble small yams. Fruit red, in grapelike clusters of 50 to 100. The tough outer skin of berry encloses an intensely sweet, white, semisolid mucilaginous material which surrounds a friable, thorny seed. Tubers, stems, and bark used medicinally.

378651. *THAUMATOCOCCUS DANIELLII* (Benn.) Benth. **Marantaceae.**

Large leaves used in Africa for wrapping food products. Fruit fleshy,
