- 383326.** *BEWSIA BIFLORA* (Hack.) Goosens. Gramineae.
 Clarement farm, near car park above Inyangombi Falls. Elevation 1,800 m. Rough, open grassland with bracken scrub, stony granite sandveld soil. Locally very common. February 1973.
- 383327.** *ERAGROSTIS CAPENSIS* (Thunb.) Trin. Gramineae. **Lovegrass.**
 1060. Rusape Town Lands near electric transformer station. Elevation 1,400 m. Densely tufted perennial with closely packed old sheaths at base. Culms mostly 60 to 90 high, erect, slender. Leaves mostly basal, blades almost filiform. Inflorescence panicles, narrow and scantily branched, mostly 8 to 10 cm. long. Spikelets ovate, brown, 5 to 7 mm. long, many flowered, florets closely imbricate. Disturbed veld between main road and Station. Very shallow, poor granite sandveld, partly waterlogged soil. Locally common in poorly drained areas. October 1972.
- 383328.** *ERAGROSTIS NINDENSIS* Fic. & Hiern
 1065. Granite whaleback (ruwari) Nitsanga near Rowa School. Elevation 1,200 m. Shallow soils fringing the woodland near top of exposed granite. Detritus and shallow sand soil. Locally occasional. March 1973.
- 383329.** *ERIOCHRYSIS PALLIDA* Munro Gramineae.
 907. Mountain Home, Penhalonga. Roadside vlei on main road. Elevation 1,200 m. Black vlei clay soil. Occasional. March 1973.
- 383330.** *EUSTACHYS PASPALOIDES* (Vahl) Lanza & Mattei Gramineae.
 831b. Townlands on main road to Beira, 80.5 km. west of old border post. Elevation 1,100 m. Disturbed road verges into mixed Msasa woodland. Grows in patches, also in adjacent open woodland that is apparently undisturbed. Perennial, mostly 50 to 70 cm. high, base strongly flattened, leaf sheaths folded, blades sharply keeled. Inflorescence digitate, racemes 5 to 8, brown. Two forms occur here, one with bright green leaves, the other with blue-green. This is the blue-green form. Granite gravel and rubble soil. Occasional. December 1968.
