533. On Route 1, three km south on the banks of Rio de La Plata, 22 km east of Colonia. Stoloniferous, warm-season perennial grass to 0.6 m tall. Coarse stem form. Plant was not flowering. Wild.

400990. PASPALUM REPENS Bergius Gramineae.

535. On banks of Rio de La Plata, 23 km north of Colonia. Stoloniferous plant with large stems. Leaf sheaths have purple color, large leaves. Wild.

400991. PENNISETUM LATIFOLIUM Spreng. Gramineae.

534. On Route 1 beside Arroyo Riachuelo, 14 km east of Colonia. Rhizomatous perennial warm-season grass. Leaves rather coarse. Plant not flowering. Normally obtains a height of 1.8 m. Wild.
