404277. 67. On BR 285 near Muitos Capoes, 43 km west of Vacaria. Plant very small, approximately 51 to 70 cm high. Fine stems and leaves. Wild.
404278. 75. Barreto, Rio Grande do Sul. Prostrate leafy plant, basal crown 3 cm in diameter. Wild.
404279. 78. On road to Nova Prata, 3 km southeast of Barreto. Erect plant to 122 cm high. Wild.
404280. 124. On BR 116, 20 km north of Vacaria. Erect plant approximately 0.61 m high. Flowers yellow. Wild.
404281 and 404282. *AESCHYNOMENE FALCATA* (Poir.) DC. Fabaceae.
404281. 100. Agricultural Experimental Station, near Guaiba. Small, fragile plant to 15 cm high, 30 cm in diameter. Wild.
404282. 680. On BR 290, 59 km east of Sao Gabriel. Prostrate, viny, perennial plant. Growth habit similar to *Adesmia*. No nodules found. Wild.
404283. *ANDROPOGON SELLOANUS* (Hack.) Hack. Poaceae. **Bluestem.**
 643. On Route BR 293, 37 km west of Dom Pedrito. Perennial, bunchgrass to 76 cm high. Inflorescences have white, flowery pubescence. Wild.
404284 and 404285. *AXONOPUS ARGENTINUS* Parodi Poaceae. **Carpetgrass.**
404284. 28. Agricultural Experiment Station, Vacaria. Plant approximately 76 cm high when in flower. Dense growth of basal leaves. Wild.
404285. 621. On Route BR 293, 44 km east of Bage. Large, robust plant with inflorescence 1.2 m high. Leaves 0.9 m tall, sparse, coarse, with bluegreen color. Wild.
404286. *AXONOPUS COMPRESSUS* (Sw.) Beauv. **Tropical carpetgrass.**
 1. Agricultural Experiment Station. Guaiba. Sod forming grass to 51 cm high when in flower. Growing in moist, abandoned area. Wild.
