405036 to 405053. HIBISCUS CANNABINUS L. Malvaceae. Kenaf.

405036. 75-1. On Highway A-109, 6 km west of Athi River, Machakos District. Elevation 1,500 m. Branched, bushy annual to 2.5 m tall. Most plants leafless, seed capsules ripe. One small plant with flower buds, larger one with flower and green capsules. Flowers purple with dark petal spot. Growing in rocky, gray-black soil in disturbed area in association with *H. trionum* an orange flowered mallow. Wild.

405037. 75-7. On Highway A-104, 40 km north of Namanga, Kaijado District. Typical purple flowered East African kenaf. Very few capsules ripe. Growing in grassy swale formed by water draining under road through culvert. Cotton strainers present, also white flowered *Hibiscus*. Wild.

405038. 75-12. On Highway A-3, Thika-Garissa Road, 25 km east of Thika, Kiambu District. Elevation 1,500 m. Spiny annual with purple flowers. Deeply palmately, lobed leaves. Roadside seed in tall grass. Occurs for several miles along this road. Wild.

405039. 75-14. On Highway A-3, Thika-Garissa Road, 36 km east of Thika, Kiambu District. Spiny annual with washed-out lavender flowers. Deeply palmately, lobed leaves. Wild.

405040. 75-15. On Highway A-3, Thika-Garissa Road, 29 km east of Thika, Kiambu District. Elevation 1,500 m. Spiny annual with washed-out lavender flowers. Deeply palmately, lobed leaves. Remnant seed collected from old, shattered capsules. Similar to P.I. 405039. Wild.

405041. 75-132. On Highway A-3, Thika-Garissa Road, 18 km east of Thika, Kiambu District. Spiny, branched annual to 3 m tall. Flowers cream with dark purple petal spot. Leaves deeply lobed. Growing in sisal hedge row with native grasses and shrubs. Wild.
