443728. 78-36c. Department of Horticulture, Univ. of Hawaii. K 441. Collected February 08, 1978. Along Highway 180, 2km south of Lerma, Campeche. Plants to 6m tall. Branches from base, thin, straight. Leaflets large. No evidence of *L. leucocephala* x *L. shannonii* hybrids in area. Tree. Wild. Seed.
443729. 78-39c. Department of Horticulture, Univ. of Hawaii. K 444. Collected February 08, 1978. Seven km south of Lerma, Campeche. Plants small. Pods with heavy insect damage. Tree. Wild. Seed.
443730. 78-40c. Department of Horticulture, Univ. of Hawaii. K 445. Collected February 08, 1978. Leguminous forest on calcareous hills, 10km south of Lerma, Campeche. Plants to 10m tall. Pods thin, less than 1 cm wide. Tree. Wild. Seed.
443731. 78-42c. Department of Horticulture, Univ. of Hawaii. K 447. Collected February 08, 1978. Between Highway 180 and beach near Seybaplaya, Campeche. Tree. Wild. Seed.
443732. 78-46c. Department of Horticulture, Univ. of Hawaii. K 451. Collected February 09, 1978. Two km west of Berriozakal, Chiapas. 800m. Rainfall 110cm per annum. Plants to 6m tall, apparently photoperiod sensitive. Local name Uach. Tree. Wild. Seed.
443733. 78-68c. Department of Horticulture, Univ. of Hawaii. K 471. Collected February 15, 1978. Along Highway 195, 1 km southwest of Cardenas, Chiapas. 1000m. Arroyos wetter than surrounding area, rainfall 80cm per annum. Plants to 8m. Leaves abscise as pods fall. Flowering synchronous. Pods puberulent. Tree. Wild. Seed.
443734. 78-69. Department of Horticulture, Univ. of Hawaii. K 472. Collected February 15, 1978. One km southeast of Cardenas, Chiapas. Single plant. Pods early maturing, abundant. Tree. Wild. Seed.
443735. 78-70c. Department of Horticulture, Univ. of Hawaii. K 473. Collected February 15, 1978. Arroyos along Highway 190, 3km southwest of Cintalpa de Figueroa, Chiapas. Plants to 7m tall. Pods slightly glabrous, dehisce rapidly at maturity. Tree. Wild. Seed.
