Ears 20 to 23cm average length, 12 to 16 rows. Seeds deeply dented. Reportedly highly resistant to southern Corn Leaf Blight. Grown by Hicks family in Eastern Tennessee for generations. Primarily for hog feed. Cultivated. Seed.

452031. A-1765. United States. Ottumwa, Iowa. D. Mack. Collected January 20, 1977. Pod corn, husks and pods deep purple. Cobs white and red. Cultivated. Seed.

452032. A-1766. Early Butler. Collected January 21, 1977. Area of Butler, Pennsylvania. Cobs to 12cm long, red. Seeds medium yellow dent, with scattered white caps. Plants dry rapidly after physiological maturity, adapted to NE U.S. where length of growing season permits. Cultivated. Seed.
