MANGO OF THE DIVINE VARIETY IN FRUIT AT THE UNITED STATES PLANT INTRODUCTION FIELD STATION, MIAMI, FLA.

This variety was introduced from Trinidad, British West Indies, in 1907. It has proved to be a vigorous grower and is now in fruit for the first time.
