



THE PITOMBA TREE OF BRAZIL (*EUGENIA LUSCHNATHIANA*), S. P. I. No. 37017.

A tropical fruit tree of the myrtle family which deserves to be tested in Florida and southern California because of its value as an ornamental and fruit tree, bearing remarkably attractive, rich orange-yellow fruits about the size and shape of a small Seckel pear, with long persistent sepals.
