



AN OLD IMBÚ TREE (*SPONDIAS TUBEROSA*) AT BREJO, BRAZIL, S. P. I. NO. 37018.

The cattle browse on the lower branches of the imbú and the ground underneath is often carpeted with the plumlike juicy fruits, which are pale greenish yellow in color and of an acid taste.
