



THE BAKOPARY (*RHEEDIA BRASILIENSIS* (MART.) PLANCH. AND TRIANA), S. P. I.

The bakopary, native of the State of Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, and occasionally planted in gardens, is a handsome ornamental tree and produces bright-yellow fruits with translucent, white flesh. The flavor is subacid, delicate, and spicy, strongly suggestive of the mangosteen, to which it is related and for which it may prove a good stock. (Photographed at Rio de Janeiro by Messrs.
