



A FIELD OF CAATINGUEIRO GRASS (*CHLORIS ELEGANS* H. B. K.), S. P. I. No. 38023.

This dry-land grass has been planted experimentally in the Horto Florestal at Joazeiro, State of Bahia, Brazil. It resists the severe climate of this region and produces a fairly good yield.
