



**THE LONGAN, DIMOCARPUS LONGAN LOUR. (NEPHELIUM LONGANA CAMBESS.),
IN FRUIT IN FLORIDA. (SEE S. P. I. NO. 41053.)**

This highly prized southern Chinese fruit tree bears abundantly in Florida, but the fruits appear to have little value, perhaps because selection has not been carried on to any extent. The profuse fruiting habit, the flourishing condition of this tree in Reasoner Brothers' tropical fruit shed, and the value placed on the fruit by the Chinese indicate that a thorough study of the various strains of this tree should be made.
