



**A HARDY LOW-GROWING HEDGE PLANT (CARAGANA PYGMAEA (L.) DC.), S. P. I. No. 41479.**

There is a growing demand for hedge plants and windbreak plants on the Plains of the Dakotas. The tall-growing Caraganas play a great rôle as windbreaks on the Canadian prairies, and this handsome low-growing species of the same genus is worthy of a place in the dooryards and along the drives throughout the bleak northwestern country.
