



THE MANAWA YAM, FROM THE REPUBLIC OF PANAMA. (DIOSCOREA SP., S. P. I. No. 42052.)

The mealy whiteness of the flesh when cooked, the smoothness of the skin, and the shape and size of this yam make it an extremely desirable variety for table use. The first introduction did not succeed at the place where tested, but the unusually attractive appearance and excellent qualities of this variety make it worthy of the extensive trials in Florida which are now contemplated.
