



TUBERS OF THE WHITE YAMPEE, A VARIETY OF YAM GROWN IN THE CANAL ZONE. (DIOSCOREA TRIFIDA L. F., S. P. I. NO. 42053.)

This yampee is of fine quality and will furnish the South with another food equal to the best potatoes if it can be grown there successfully.
