



THE ANAY, A NEW RELATIVE OF THE AVOCADO. (HUFELANDIA ANAY BLAKE, S. P. I. No. 43432.)

The anay grows wild in northern and western Guatemala. Its fruit resembles an avocado of the Mexican race in general appearance. The flavor is exceedingly pleasant, but the flesh is rather scanty.
