



A PROMISING HYBRID ANONA. (ANNONA CHERIMOLA × A. SQUAMOSA, S. P. I. No. 45181.)

The cherimoya has not fruited well in Florida, but the sugar-apple has. Since the cherimoya is much superior in flavor and shipping qualities to the sugar-apple it is believed that in this hybrid an advantageous combination of characters has been obtained and that a free-fruited type of hybrid is now available. Since it ripens in the winter like the cherimoya and is a delicious table fruit, it will be valuable for marketing in the tourist season.
