



**A HANDSOME RED-BERRIED SHRUB FROM EASTERN ASIA. (*VIBURNUM DILATATUM* THUNB., S. P. I. No. 45974.)**

A fine *Viburnum* requiring less moisture than most other species and therefore suited for dooryard use. It blooms profusely in June, trusses being produced from short twigs down the side as well as at the top of the branch. The flowers are pure white.
