



**THE BENNETT SOURSOP, A CHOICE VARIETY FROM COSTA RICA. (ANNONA MURICATA L., S. P. I. No. 51050.)**

Superior forms of the soursop, a valuable fruit of the American Tropics, have not yet been established horticulturally. Practically all of the trees now growing throughout the world are seedlings. Since they vary in productiveness and in the character of their fruit it is a simple matter to select the best ones and propagate them by budding or grafting. The variety here illustrated is one which was grown at the Zent Farm of the United Fruit Company near Port Limon, Costa Rica, and is considered unusually valuable because of the large size and excellent quality of its fruits as well as the productiveness of the tree.
