



**AN AVENUE OF THE SIAMESE MAIKRABAO TREES, WHICH PRODUCE AN OIL VERY SIMILAR TO THAT OF THE CHAULMOOGRA TREE. (HYDNOCARPUS ANTHELMINTHICA PIERRE, S. P. I. NO. 52468.)**

Seeds from the trees shown here were forwarded to Washington under S. P. I. No. 51773, and later, under S. P. I. No. 52468, more seeds, collected from trees near Korat in eastern Siam, were sent in. The oil from these trees is very similar to the true chaulmoogra oil and is used in the same way in the treatment of leprosy. (Photographed by J. F.
