



THE TOCTE, A NATIVE ECUADORIAN WALNUT TREE. (*JUGLANS* SP.,  
S. P. I. No. 52611.)

This tree strongly resembles our native black walnut (*Juglans nigra*), but the foliage is perhaps larger. The nuts are  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inches in diameter, and the kernel has a mild pleasant flavor.
