



YOUNG BRANCHES OF THE BARAJILLO. (MEIBOMIA RENSONI PAINTER;

This new leguminous shrub from Salvador, in addition to serving as a green cover crop, is said to be an excellent forage for livestock. The plant thrives in poor soil and is said to resist drought admirably. It should be tried in tropical regions, where it may prove to be more valuable than the pigeon-pea, now used extensively as a cover crop and soil builder.
