Although the Surinam cherry (*Eugenia uniflora*) has become a well known shrub in Florida its frequent use as a hedge in Brazil may suggest a similar use for it in Florida. It is an evergreen and its crimson fruits ripen throughout the winter and when perfectly ripe are very palatable. It is not spiny and in this respect is inferior to Carissa.
