



TUNG-OIL TREE (*Aleurites fordii* Hemsley), S. P. I. No. 21013.

A very prolific but small-fruited tung-oil tree growing at the Agricultural Experiment Station, Experiment, Ga. This tree when planted out in 1908 was 1 year old from seed, and when 7 years old, in 1914, it produced over 2½ bushels of fruit, containing 45½ pounds of clean seeds. These seeds were given S. P. I.
