The hardiness of this South American fruiting bush is something of a surprise. It promises to grow and fruit as far north as Alabama and Georgia. It appears to be cross-fertilized by birds, which are fond of the thick petals of the flowers. The large-fruited selected varieties of California deserve a trial in the Gulf States.
