



AN INTERESTING HEDGE PLANT FROM NEW ZEALAND. *DODONAEA VISCOSA*. (SEE S. P. I. NO. 36813.)

The New Zealand *Dodonaea* is proving to be one of the best hedge plants for tropical and subtropical regions. It is beautifully dense and green, responds to the shears perfectly, and when taken in hand early makes a compact wall clear to the ground. Seedling plants form a deep taproot and must be transplanted with care on that account.
