



**AN INTERESTING HOLLY FROM THE ANDES.**

(*Ilex* sp.; S. P. I. No. 51788.)

From an elevation of 10,000 feet, near Bogota, Colombia, has come this new holly, whose behavior in the greenhouses at Washington indicates that it may prove to be an ornamental plant of unusual value. Its shapely form, even when very small, and its handsome, glossy green foliage make it a pot plant of attractive appearance. When larger it produces red berries in great abundance. It should prove hardy enough for cultivation outdoors in California and Florida, if not generally throughout the Gulf Coast region.
